### Dinner Volunteers at Serenity Inn

#### What is Serenity Inn?

Serenity Inn is a residence for men in recovery who have completed treatment and are working to maintain sobriety, find employment, and rebuild life skills. Typically, 9-12 men and an Innkeeper live at the Inn at any given time.

#### FPLC Longstanding Involvement

Since Serenity Inn opened in 2004, Fox Point Lutheran Church has supported its Dinner Fellowship ministry. FPLC volunteers provide dinner three times each month—more than 600 meals over the years. Think of the number of men who have been impacted through these shared meals, and experienced encouragement, connection, and a welcoming community.

#### What's Involved for Dinner Fellowship Volunteers?

Prepare or purchase (see ideas below) a meal and bring it warm to the Inn (2825 W. Brown St., Milwaukee). Volunteers are encouraged to stay, share the meal, and hear the residents' recovery stories, though meals may also be dropped off or delivered. One of the men will guide the evening. The residents handle setup assistance, cleanup, and carrying items to and from your car. Families with middle-school-aged children and older are welcome, and friends can team up to prepare and serve a meal together.

#### Why You Should Sign Up

Any number of residents at the Inn have told volunteers that they rarely, if ever, sat down for a meal with their own families growing up. Creating a "family environment" for the men in recovery at the Inn sets the program apart from any other in the area and helps the men realize "they are somebody." People care about them! Their openness and appreciation for the meal and your company is visible.

#### Choosing Our Next Reads

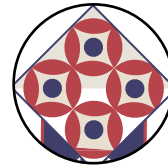
We take the summer off except to meet in June to choose our next books.

Hello!

*“Jesus told His disciples, “You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden... let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven.” – Matthew 5:14-16*

Three objects grace my computer desk. One amethyst drusy or geode, a sparkling geologic wonder, facets iridescent with fractured light. Alongside it, a green glittery cat's toy that moves light around like a disco ball and next to it, a peacock brooch, with plumage glinted in indigo and pink stones. It's a puzzle to me as to why I would include such odd things as enjoyable and comforting objects, yet they are... and I finally figured out the reason.

It's the light! The one common denominator. The light seizes each one, captures its beauty and changes it from ordinary to exquisite. With a tilt of my head I can be mesmerized, comforted, even energized as the light transforms them. Without it to reflect and magnify beauty, they would be lacking. The geode especially... forged by hundreds of years of the earth's pressures and waters and darkness and light in a slow process of time and fusion, out of a hollow cavity, God takes a lump of mineral, transforms it, and invites us to see His vision of change and growth.

In Matthew we are called to shine Jesus' light through our actions. As we walk in this world present day, writing from ancient times has become a teaching moment for all time! Jesus invites us to turn from just reading His invitation to actually making His love and grace and yes, truth, visible right now. We can carry out His mission with each other, in our churches, our neighborhoods, our communities, our cities and our nation. We may not always feel comfortable, but with His light, there is always love enough and we know that we can walk easily with Him at our side.
